Dhaka, the 15th January 1986

No. S.R.O. 23-L/86.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following amendments in the Primary School Teachers Recruitment Rules, 1983, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules,—

- (A) In sub-rule (3) of rule 4, for the full-stop at the end a colon shall be substituted and thereafter the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

“Provided that 20% of the posts shall be reserved for the dependents of serving or retired Head Teachers or Assistant Teachers of Primary Schools having requisite qualifications.

Explanation.—In this sub-rule, the term ‘dependents’ means the sons and daughters of serving, deceased or retired Head Teachers or Assistant Teachers of Primary Schools and wholly dependent upon them and in the event of death of a Head Teacher or Assistant Teacher, the widow or widower, as the case may be.”

(B) In the Schedule,—

- (i) In the third column against Serial No. 1 in the first column for the words and figure “Maximum 30 years”, the figures and words “25 to 35 years” shall be substituted.

- (ii) (a) In the third column against Serial No. 2 in the first column for the words and figure "Maximum 30 years" the figures and words "18 to 30 years" shall be *substituted*.
- (b) In the proviso in the fifth column against Serial No. 2 in the first column, *after* clause (i), the following new clause (ia) shall be *inserted*, namely :—
- "(ia) had passed the Certificate-in-Education course during the academic year 1983-84."
