NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 29th January, 1986

No. S.R.O. 45-L/86.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 23 of the Extradition Act, 1974 (LVIII of 1974), the Government is pleased to add the following entry in the Schedule to the said Act, namely:—

In the aforesaid Schedule, after entry 23, the following new entries shall be added, namely:—

- 24. Unlawful seizure, or exercise of control, of an aircraft in flight.
- Acts of violence against a person on board an aircraft in flight endangering the safety of that aircraft.
- Destruction of, or damage to an, aircraft in service as is likely to endanger its safety in flight.
- Placing of device or substance on aircraft in service likely to cause destruction or damage to such aircraft.
- Destruction of, damage to, or interference with, air navigation facilities used for international air navigation.
- 29. Communication of false information endangering the safety of aircraft.
