No. S.R.O. 72-L/76/M.V.(RTL)/1A.1/76.—The following draft of certain further amendments to the Motor Vehicles Rules, 1940, which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 41 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1939 (IV of 1939), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of section 133 of the said Act for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the draft will be taken into consideration on or after 29th March, 1976.

Any objection for suggestion which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft before the date specified will be considered by the Government:

**Draft Amendments**

In the aforesaid Rules, in rule 35A,—

(1) in sub-rule (6),—

(a) in the first paragraph,—

- (i) in clause (i), for the letters "CD" the word "দুত" shall be substituted;
- (ii) in clause (ii), for the letters "CC" the letters "ককো" shall be substituted;
- (iii) in clause (iii), for the letter "X" the letter "অ" shall be substituted;

(iv) for clauses (iv) and (v) the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

- “(iv) the letters “জাস” in the case of vehicles belonging to UN and its agencies;
- (v) the letters “সাস” in the case of vehicles belonging to Aid Missions, experts, officials and International Relief Agencies coming under agreements;
- (vi) the letters “রেফ” in the case of vehicles belonging to International Red Cross.”;

(b) in second paragraph, for the words “or UN Agencies or Aid Missions” the words and commas “or UN and its agencies, Aid Missions or International Red Cross, or International Relief Agencies coming under agreements” shall be *substituted*;

(c) in the third paragraph, for the figure “999” the figure “9999” shall be *substituted*; and

(2) for sub-rule (8) the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“While issuing the certificate of registration, the special registering authority shall ask the Diplomatic, Consular or Trade Mission or any member thereof, United Nations, International Red Cross, Aid Missions, Experts, officials and International Relief Agencies coming under agreements owning the vehicle to get it physically verified and to get a certificate of such verification recorded in the certificate of registration within one month from the date of issue of the certificate of registration by any of the following officers, namely:—

- (i) Superintendent of Police, Dacca.
- (ii) Superintendent of Police, Chittagong.
- (iii) Superintendent of Police, Rajshahi.
- (iv) Superintendent of Police, Khulna.
- (v) Maintenance Inspector-cum-Inspectors of Motor Vehicles appointed by the Government.”.

### NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 16th February, 1976.

No. S.R.O. 73-L/76/4/Na-3/76/93.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service (First) Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

1. **Short title.**—These may be called the Gazetted Officers (Development and Planning Wing of the Ministry of Agriculture) Recruitment Rules, 1976.



2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) “appointing authority” means the Government and includes, in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment such post or class of posts;
- (b) “Commission” means the Bangladesh Public Service (First) Commission;
- (c) “Probationer” means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (d) “requisite qualification”, in relation to a specified post, means the qualification specified in column 5 of the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (e) “Schedule” means the Schedule annexed to these rules; and
- (f) “specified post” means a post specified in the Schedule.

3. **Procedure of recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment; or
- (b) by promotion from amongst persons already holding specified posts or other posts mentioned in the Schedule for the purpose.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification, and in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit, if any, laid down in the Schedule for that post:

Provided that, in the case of a person who is already in the service of the Republic, the age limit may be relaxed by five years.

4. **Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in, Bangladesh;
- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director of Health Services to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post;
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

5. **Appointment by promotion.**—(1) Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made after considering the recommendations of such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may set up for the purpose and in consultation with the Commission.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post if he has not been confirmed in any post on the ground of unsatisfactory service records.

6. **Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment:

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation in the case of any person by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Soon after the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority—

- (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall confirm him; and
- (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during the period was not satisfactory, may, in the case of the direct recruitment, terminate his service, and, in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

**No. S.R.O. 74-L/76.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Civil Aviation Ordinance, 1960 (XXXII of 1960), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Aircraft Rules, 1937, the same having been previously published as required by sub-section (2) of section 13 of the said Ordinance, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules, in Part XI, *after* rule 81, the following new rule 81A shall be *inserted*, namely:—

**“81A. Fees for the use of airport, etc.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of sub-rule (2), every passenger emplaning a scheduled or non-scheduled aircraft from an airport or aerodrome shall be liable to pay a fee for the use of, and for services provided at such airport or aerodrome at the following rates, namely:—

(2) The provisions of sub-rule (1) shall not apply to—

- (a) Heads of States and Government along with their entourage;
- (b) Ministers and high dignitaries of foreign countries visiting Bangladesh as state guests;
- (c) transit passengers leaving Bangladesh by the same aircraft boarding which they entered the country or by the next available flight by which they have to reach their destination provided that a scheduled night stop is not involved;
- (d) children under two years of age; and
- (e) such other person or persons as the Director-General, Civil Aviation Department may, by general or special order, specify in this behalf.

(3) No person in charge of an aircraft shall allow any passenger to board the aircraft unless such passenger has paid the fee payable under sub-rule (1).

(4) The fee payable by a passenger under sub-rule (1) shall be collected in the following manner, namely:—

- (a) in cash, or
- (b) by affixing special stamp on the air ticket, or
- (c) by any other procedure as the Director-General of Civil Aviation Department may specify in this behalf.
