ORDER

Dacca, the 11th February 1975.

No. S.R.O. 74/L/75/266-MFCS-II/1C-1/75.—In exercise of the powers conferred by rule 17 of the Emergency Powers Rules, 1975, the Government is pleased to make the following order, namely :

1. This Order may be called the Emergency (Regulation of Rationed Articles and Internal Procurement of Rice and Paddy) Order, 1975.

2. In this Order, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context, the words and expressions used in this Order shall have the same respective meanings assigned to them in the Bengal Rationing Order, 1943, the East Bengal Urban Area Rationing Regulations, 1956, and the East Pakistan Modified Rationing Order, 1956.

3. (1) No person shall have in his possession or control any fake ration document.

(2) No person shall obtain or attempt to obtain any ration document furnishing false or incorrect information.

(3) No person shall draw any rationed article for any week on the strength of a ration document of a person who is absent from the rationed area for that week.

4. (1) No appointed retailer shall have in his possession or control any fake ration document.

(2) No appointed retailer shall give any short weight of the rationed articles purchased on the strength of a valid ration document.

(3) No appointed retailer shall sell any rationed article to any unauthorised person or at a rate higher than the rate fixed by the Government.

(4) Every appointed retailer shall maintain proper and up-to-date accounts of the rationed articles received by him; and the physical stock of the rationed articles in his possession or under his control shall conform with the stock shown in the accounts maintained under this sub-paragraph.

5. The Government or any officer authorised by it in this behalf may cancel the appointment of any retailer without assigning any reason therefor.

6. (1) No person shall have in his possession any ration document in the name of any fake establishment.

(2) No establishment shall draw any rationed article submitting false or incorrect reports or information.

(3) No establishment shall use any rationed article drawn by it for any purpose other than the purpose for which it has been drawn.

(4) No manufacturing establishment shall use any rationed article for the manufacture of any goods except those for which the rationed articles are issued to him nor shall such establishments sell any manufactured goods at a price higher than the price fixed by the Government.

(5) Every establishment shall maintain proper and up to date accounts of the rationed articles received by it and the physical stock of the rationed articles in its possession or under its control shall conform with the stock shown in the accounts maintained under this sub-paragraph.

7. The Government or any officer authorised by it in this behalf may, at any time, cancel, vary or amend any ration document issued in favour of any person or any establishment.

8. If the number of manufacturing establishments situated in any particular area be considered in excess of the normal requirement or, if the functioning of any particular manufacturing establishment be considered un-satisfactory, the officers authorised by the Government in this behalf to issue ration documents may cancel the ration documents of any such establishment; and the manufacturing establishment whose ration document is so cancelled shall surrender such documents to the officer who cancelled the document.

9. No person other than an appointed wholesaler or an appointed retailer shall sell or offer for sale wheat, wheat products or sugar within any rationed area.

10. Movement of any rationed articles out of any rationed area, except on Government account or by an appointed wholesaler or retailer, is prohibited:

Provided that any person going out of the rationed area may take his rationed articles for his *bona fide* consumption.

11. Every person including a carrier shall account for the rationed articles kept in his custody in the Government godown or entrusted to him for transportation either by road or river.



12. (1) Every carrier engaged by the Government for transportation of rationed articles shall deliver the entire quantity received by him less the permissible shortage to the consignee within reasonable time.

(2) The Government may, without assigning any reason, terminate the contract executed with a carrier for carrying of rationed articles.

13. No person shall commit theft of rationed articles from any Government godown or from the custody of any carrier engaged by the Government for the transportation of the same.

14. No person shall loiter about any Government godown or at a place of loading or unloading of rationed articles with intent to commit theft of, or for causing mischief to, the rationed articles.

15. No person shall withhold or obstruct or cause to be withheld or obstructed delivery of the stock of rice or paddy assessed on him under the Food-grains (Disposal and Acquisition) Order, 1948 or under any other law for the time being in force.

No. S.R.O. 75-L/75/IF-VI-132/74-ST/107.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 74 of the Stamp Act, 1899 (Act II of 1899), the Government is pleased to make the following amendments in the rules for regulating the supply and sale of stamps and stamped papers, issued under notification No. 6442 S.R., dated the 2nd December 1899, and incorporated in the Stamp Manual, Volume I, namely:—

In the said rules,—

(1) after rule 2, the following shall be inserted, namely:—

“2A. Every application for the grant of renewal of license of stamp vendors shall be accompanied by a chalan showing deposit of, in the case of an application for the grant of a license, Taka twenty-five and, in the case of an application for renewal of license, Taka fifteen in a Treasury or Sub-Treasury under head “IX—Stamps A—Non-Judicial—Miscellaneous”.

(2) In rule 4,—

- (a) for the words and comma “under the license,” the words and comma “under the license, the period for which the license shall be valid,”;
- (b) for the words “shall be revocable” the words “shall be renewable but shall be revocable” shall be *substituted*; and
- (c) in the Form for license for vend of stamps, after condition 10, the following shall be *inserted*, namely:—

“II. your license shall be valid, unless renewed, for a period of one year from the date of issue of the license.”.
