#### NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 12th March 1986

No. S.R.O. 83-L/86.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 176A of the Army Act, 1952 (XXXIX of 1952), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Army Regulations (Rules), 1960, namely:—

In the aforesaid Regulations (Rules), for APPENDIX 'H' the following shall be substituted, namely:-

#### "APPENDIX 'H'

(Vide Rule 257)

Compensation payable to Government on Voluntary Retirement/Resignation of Commission by an Officer.

1. A regular or non-regular officer who applies for voluntary retirement or resigns his commission before completion of the following minimum service on the Effective List (excluding ante-date of commission) after having received training/qualified at courses specified hereunder or during training/course is liable to pay compensation to the Government as laid down in the Table below. Provided that these rules shall not prejudice the absolute authority of the Chief of Army Staff or the Government to refuse such an application, and also it will

not affect the provisions regarding retention of non-regular officers until their services are required:

The financial liability will be aggregated where a second obligation commences before the first is fully discharged by completing the required period of service given in column (3) of the above Table, provided that period of service on a course/training, subsequent to commissioning ex-Bangladesh Military Academy shall count towards fulfilment of the minimum service obligation under serials 1, 2 and 3 above.
- 3. The prescribed forms of bonds to be signed by cadets and their sureties before joining Bangladesh Military Academy are contained in the "Regulations Governing the Grant of Commissions in the Army" and the form to be signed by officers attending courses/training after commissioning is reproduced in the Annexure below.
