NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 16th March 1986

No. S.R.O. 89-L/86/984/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 4 of the Sales Tax Ordinance, 1982 (XVIII of 1982), and section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Government is pleased to exempt the goods specified in column (2) of the Table below and falling under the Tariff Heading Nos. of the First Schedule to the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), as specified in column (1) of the said Table from whole of the sales tax and so much of customs duties leviable thereon as is in excess of the rate specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) of that Table provided that these goods are imported between the 1st day of May, 1986, and the 31st day of May, 1986 (both days inclusive):

**Dhaka, the 17th March 1986**

**No. S.R.O. 90-L/86.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the section 10 of the Wireless Telegraphy Act, 1933 (XVII of 1933), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Television Receiving Apparatus (Possession and Licencing) Rules, 1970, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules,—

- (a) in rule 2,—
- (i) in clause (g), for the words "Bangladesh Television" the words and brackets "the National Broadcasting Authority (Television Wing)" shall be *substituted*; and
  - (ii) in clause (i), for the word "Corporation" the words "National Broadcasting Authority" shall be *substituted*;
- (b) in rule 9, after the word "person", the word and comma "selling," shall be *inserted*;
- (c) after rule 12, the following new rule shall be *inserted*, namely:—
- "12A. (1) The Licencing Authority may, by order in writing, suspend or cancel any licence issued to any person for breach of any of the provisions of these rules.
- (2) Any person aggrieved by an order under sub-rule (1) may, within thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, prefer an appeal to the Chairman, National Broadcasting Authority.
- (3) The Chairman of the National Broadcasting Authority may, after giving an opportunity of being heard, give his decision and his decision in such appeal shall be final."
