NOTIFICATION

Dhakā, the 13th March, 1983

No. S. R. O. 102-L/83.—The following draft of the Certificate of Competency Examination for Diploma Holders in Marine Engineering Technology Rules, 1983, which the Government proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 22 of the Inland Shipping Ordinance, 1976 (LXXII of 1976), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of that section for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, and notice is hereby given that said draft will be taken into consideration after a period of thirty days from the date of its publication in the official Gazette. Any objection or suggestion received from any person in respect of the said draft before the expiry of the period specified will be taken into consideration by the Government:—

1. **Short title**—These rules may be called the Certificate of Competency Examination for Diploma Holders in Marine Engineering Technology Rules, 1983.

2. **Eligibility to appear at the Certificate of Competency Examination.**—Persons holding diploma in Marine Engineering Technology shall be eligible to appear at the Certificate of Competency Examination if they fulfil the

following conditions for the certificate of competency examinations of the grades specified below :

- (a) **Certificate of Competency Examination as Second Class Engine-Driver (Motor)**: The diploma holders shall be allowed to take the Certificate of Competency Examination for Second Class Engine-Driver (Motor) immediately after passing the diploma examination conducted by the Bangladesh Technical Education Board.
- (b) **Certificate of Competency Examination as First Class Engine-Driver (Motor)**: The diploma holders shall after obtaining the Certificate of Competency as Second Class Engine-Driver (Motor), be required to complete sixteen months' engine room service on inland ships having over 965 brake horse-power as Second Driver and twenty months' engine room service on inland ships having brake horse-power between 100 and 965 as Second driver or in-charge driver before they appear at the Certificate of Competency Examination for First Class Engine-Driver (Motor).
- (c) **Certificate of Competency Examination as Inland Engineer (Motor)**: The diploma holders shall be eligible to take the Certificate of Competency Examination for inland Engineer (Motor), if they have served twenty-one months on regular watch (in any capacity) on the main engines of sea-going motor vessels of not less than 565 brake horse-power or thirty months on similar inland ships.
