No. S.R.O.109-L/83/770/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in this Ministry's notification No. 233-L/82/725/Cus., dated the 30th June, 1982, namely:—

In the aforesaid Notification, in the Table,—

- (1) for Tariff Heading No. 73.10 in column (1) and the entries relating thereto in columns (2) and (3), the following shall be *substituted*, namely:

“73.10 Medium carbon steel wire rod 40% *ad val.*”; and

- (2) for Tariff Heading No. 73.14 in column (1) and the entries relating thereto in columns (2) and (3), the following shall be *substituted*, namely:

“73.14 Medium carbon steel wire 40% *ad val.*”.
