No. S.R.O.130-L/83/93-Excise.—In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 12A of the Excise and Salt Act, 1944 (I of 1944), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in this Division's Notification No. S.R.O. 202-L/81/40-Excise, dated the 6th June, 1981, namely :—

In the aforesaid Notification, in TABLE 1, for item No. 04.10 (i) in column 1 and the entries relating thereto in columns 2 and 3 the following shall be substituted, namely :—

"04.10 Antiseptic, disinfectant, insecticide, pesticide and germicide all sorts, other than those used exclusively for agricultural purposes—

(a) Dichlorodiphenyl trichloroethane (DDT) .. Nil.

(b) All others—

If the retail price is legibly, prominently and indelibly printed on each package or container .. Five per cent of the retail price".

### NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 17th April 1983

**No. S. R. O. 131-L/83.**—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Chief Martial Law Administrator is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Civilian Officers (Directorate General of Medical Services under the Ministry of Defence) Recruitment Rules, 1983.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) “appointing authority” means the Government and includes, in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to such post or class of posts;
- (b) “probationer” means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (c) “recognised University” means a University established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other University declared by the Government, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, to be a recognised University for the purposes of these rules;
- (d) “requisite qualification”, in relation to a specified post, means the qualification prescribed in the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (e) “Schedule” means the Schedule annexed to these rules; and
- (f) “specified post” means a post specified in the Schedule.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment; or
- (b) by promotion; or
- (c) by transfer on deputation.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and, in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit prescribed in the Schedule for that post.

4. **Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of such Selection Committee as may be constituted by the Government for the purpose.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen or a permanent resident of Bangladesh;
- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.



(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment has been certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director General of Health Services or by the Civil Surgeon, as the case may be, to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person who is already in Government service or in the service of a local authority shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless he applied through his official superior.

**5. Appointment by promotion.**—(1) Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made on the recommendation of such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may constitute in this behalf.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for promotion to a specified post if he has unsatisfactory records of service.

**6. Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post, otherwise than by transfer on deputation, against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation,—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and
- (b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment:

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority,—

- (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (3) confirm him; and
- (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may,—
  - (i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
  - (ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(3) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, prescribe by order.

2 Senior Research Officer. Not exceeding 32 years, relaxable up to 37 years for persons already in Government service.

- (i) 50% by promotion from amongst the Research Officers and, if none is found suitable for promotion, by transfer on deputation of Defence Services Officers of equivalent rank and status and, if none is found suitable for such transfer, by direct recruitment; and
- (ii) 50% by direct recruitment

(i) *For promotion.*—At least 7 years' service as a Research Officer.

(ii) *For direct recruitment.*—First Class Master's Degree or Second Class Master's Degree with Second Class Honours in Chemistry or Bio-Chemistry from a recognised University with at least 7 years' experience in food nutrition or pharmacy; or Master's Degree in Chemistry or Bio-Chemistry from a recognised University with Post-Graduate diploma in Bio-Chemistry or Pharmacy from abroad and with at least 7 years' experience in Food Nutrition Pharmacy.

Publications, technical reports (or patented process and experience in guiding research and training of research scientists will be treated as additional qualification.

3 Deputy Assistant Director General of Medical Service, X-Ray Electromedical equipment. Not exceeding 32 years, relaxable up to 35 years for persons already in Government service.

By transfer on deputation of Defence Services Officers of equivalent rank and status and, if none is found suitable for such transfer, by direct recruitment.

*For direct recruitment.*—First Class Master's Degree or Second Class Master's Degree with Second Class Honours in Physics from a recognised University with at least 7 years' experience.



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Experience of work with X-Ray and Electromedical equipment will be treated as additional qualification.

No. S. R. O. 133-L/83.—In pursuance of section 78 of the Registration Act, 1908 (XVI of 1908), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Table of Fees, published under the Ministry of Land Administration and Land Reforms Notification No. S.R.O. 12-L/74/RE-169/74/219-Rstn., dated the 29th June, 1974, namely:—

In the aforesaid Table, under the heading "I. Ordinary Fees" in paragraph A, in sub-paragraph (1), for the proviso the following shall be substituted, namely:—

"Provided that for registration of Mortgage deeds in respect of loans granted by the House Building Finance Corporation established by the House Building Finance Corporation Order, 1973 (P.O. No. 7 of 1973), and the Banks constituted by the Bangladesh Banks (Nationalisation) Order, 1972 (P.O. No. 26 of 1972), registration fees shall be charged at the rate of two per cent of the total loans sanctioned under the multi-storied housing scheme and general housing scheme."
