NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 7th June, 1983

No. S.R.O. 181-L/83/777/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 4 of the Sales Tax Ordinance, 1982 (XVIII of 1982), and section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Government is pleased to exempt the goods specified in column (2) of the table below and falling under the Tariff Heading Nos. of the First Schedule to the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), as specified in column (1) of the said Table from whole of the sales tax and so much of customs-duties leviable thereon as is in excess of the rate specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) of that Table, provided that these goods are imported between the 5th day of June, 1983 and the 6th day of July, 1983 (both days inclusive):

**NOTIFICATION**

**Dhaka, the 8th June, 1983**

**No. S.R.O.182-L/83/S-IX/SE-5/83/81.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Shops and Establishments Act, 1965 (E. P. Act VII of 1965), the Government is pleased to suspend the operation of clause (a) of section 10 of the said Act in respect of those commercial establishments who are members of the Metropolitan Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Dhaka, and the Bangladesh Employers' Association and where five and a half working days in a week are observed for the month of Ramzan in 1983, subject to the following conditions, namely :—

- (a) every such worker shall be allowed an interval of at least half-an-hour during the first five working days of the week for rest or meal; and
- (b) the normal weekly working hours shall be reduced by at least two and a half hours.
