NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 19th June 1983

No. S.R.O. 193-L/83/LMVIII/1(17)/82.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Inland Water Transport (Regulation of Employment) Act, 1965 (E.P. Act III of 1965), the Government is pleased to make the following amendment in the Inland Water Transport (Regulation of Employment) Rules, 1980, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules, after rule 3, the following new rule shall be inserted namely:

"3A. Scale of fees and manner of payment.—(1) Every employer who employs five or more workers shall pay to the Board, every financial year, a fee calculated at the rate of Taka 3 per month per worker employed by him within one month of the close of that financial year by bank draft or cheque:

Provided that, where payment is made by cheque on an outstation bank, collection charges at such rate as may be charged by the bank in respect of that cheque shall also be included in the amount for which the cheque is drawn:

Provided further that no employer shall, by reason only of his liability for payment of any fee to the Board, reduce, whether directly or indirectly, the wages or other benefits to which a worker is entitled under the terms of his employment, expressed or implied, or fixed or determined under section 8.

- (2) All amounts received by the Board under sub-rule (1) shall be acknowledged by the Secretary within ten days from the date of such receipt,
- (3) The employer shall forward to the Secretary within one month of the close of every financial year, a monthwise statement showing the number of workers employed in each vessel and the amount of fees paid against them."

No. S.R.O. 195-L/83/VII-19/83.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3A of the Land Development Tax Ordinance, 1976 (XLII of 1976), the Government is pleased to authorise the Deputy Commissioner of each district to exempt from payment of land development tax, any public graveyard, public cremation ground or place of public prayer or religious worship, subject to the conditions that—

- (a) the provisions of rule 45 of the Tenancy Rules, 1955, shall apply to such exemption; and
- (b) the area of land in each case shall not exceed five acres.
