No. S.R.O.197-L/83/PE/2E-1/82.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Chittagong Port Authority Ordinance, 1976 (Ord. LH of 1976), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Notification relating to Port Limit bearing No. S.R.O. 5(R), dated the 30th June, 1960, namely:—

In the aforesaid Notification, for paragraph 1, the following shall be substituted, namely:

"1. The seaward limits of the Chittagong Port shall be as follows :-

With Patenga Beacon as centre if an arc is drawn seaward with a radius of 5½ miles till it intercepts the coast line at position Lat.: 22°-18′-45″ North, Long.: 91°-46′-30″ East, in the North and Lat.: 22°-8′-13″ North, Long.: 91°-50′-00″ East in the South, the area enclosed within the extremities of the arc".
