No. S.R.O. 198-L/83/MVRT/3M-40/83.—The following draft of certain further amendment to the Motor Vehicles Rules, 1940, which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 70 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1939 (IV of 1939), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of section 133 of the said Act, for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby give that the draft will be taken into consideration on or after the 5th July, 1983. Any objection or suggestion received from any person in respect of the said draft on or before the date specified above will be taken into consideration by the Government:

Draft Amendment

In the aforesaid Rules, after rule 162A, the following new rule shall be inserted, namely:-

"162B. Painting of bodies of stage carriages:—All stage carriages plying within the areas of the city/town mentioned in column 2 of the Table below, excluding those which are owned by the Government departments,
