No. S. R. O. 235-L/83.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the Post Office Act, 1898 (VI of 1898), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Post Office Rules, 1961, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules,—

- (1) in rule 4, in sub-rule (1), for the words "Seventy-five poisha" against the entry "Inland Aerogramme", the words "taka one" shall be substituted;
- (2) in rule 6, under the heading "Business Reply Envelope", for the words "Seventy-five poisha" the words "taka one" shall be substituted.

This Notification shall take effect on the first day of July, 1983.

NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 30th June, 1983

No. S.R.O. 236-L/83.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Dental Technicians (Government Hospitals) Recruitment Rules, 1980.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) "appointing authority" means the Director of Health Services;
- (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (c) "Probationer" means a person appointed on probation to the specified post;
- (d) "requisite qualification" in relation to the specified post, means the qualification laid down in the schedule in relation to the specified post;
- (e) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these rules; and
- (f) "Specified post" means the post specified in the Schedule.

3. **Procedure of recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and instructions relating to reservation for the purpose of clause (3) of article 29 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, appointment to the specified post shall be made by direct recruitment.

(2) No person shall be appointed to the specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and he is also within the age limit laid down in the Schedule for the post.

4. **Appointment.**—(1) No appointment to the specified post shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

- (2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to the specified post, if he—
 - (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in, Bangladesh:

Provided that this clause shall not apply in the case of a person who is already in the service of the Republic;

- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No. appointment to the specified post shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a medical Officer authorised by the Government in this behalf, to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person as selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to the specified post unless—

- (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the specified post; and
- (b) in the case of a person already in the service of the Republic or of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.

5. **Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to the specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment :

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period, terminate his service:

(3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority,—

- (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and
- (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may terminate his service.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in the specified post until he has passed examination and undergone such training as the Govt. may from time to time, prescribe.
