#### Dbaka, the 27th July 1983

No. S.R.O. 287-L/83/S-IX/SE-13/83/98.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Shops and Establishments Act, 1965 (E. P. Act VII of 1965), the Government is pleased to suspend the operation of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the aforesaid Act in respect of the shops and establishments in the areas of Cox's Bazar Jhinuk Market and Burmese Stores Market under the Cox's Bazar municipal area, district Chittegong, for a period of one year, subject to the following conditions, namely:—

- (a) the workers required to work overtime shall be paid wages at double the ordinary rates of wages for working beyond the normal working period of nine hours a day or forty-eight hours a week; and
- (b) the workers deprived of weekly holidays shall be allowed compensatory weekly holidays within the period of operation of this suspension order.
