No. 896-Pub.—The following Ordinance made by the President of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, on the 26th August, 1976, is hereby published for general information:—

**THE DACCA METROPOLITAN POLICE (AMENDMENT)  
ORDINANCE, 1976.**

Ordinance No. LXIX of 1976.

AN  
ORDINANCE

*to amend the Dacca Metropolitan Police Ordinance, 1976.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Dacca Metropolitan Police Ordinance, 1976 (Ord. III of 1976), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamations of the 20th August, 1975, and the 8th November, 1975, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Ordinance may be called the Dacca Metropolitan Police (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976.

(2) It shall come into force at once except sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 10 which shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of February, 1976.

2. **Amendment of section 2, Ord. III of 1976.**—In the Dacca Metropolitan Police Ordinance, 1976 (Ord. III of 1976), hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 2, for clause (n) the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“(n) ‘subordinate officer’ means any of the officers of the Force mentioned in section 7A;”.

3. **Insertion of new section 7A, Ord. III of 1976.**—In the said Ordinance, after section 7, the following new section shall be inserted, namely:—

“7A. **Classes and ranks of subordinate officers.**—There may be all or any of the following classes of subordinate officers of the Force, who shall take rank in the order mentioned, namely:—

- (a) Inspector,
- (b) Sub-Inspector,
- (c) Sergeant,
- (d) Assistant Sub-Inspector,
- (e) Head Constable,
- (f) Naik,
- (g) Constable.”.

4. **Substitution of section 8, Ord. III of 1976.**—In the said Ordinance, for section 8, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“8. **Appointment of subordinate officers.**—(1) The appointment of Inspectors shall be made by the Police Commissioner and the appointment of all other subordinate officers shall be made by such superior officer not below the rank of Deputy Police Commissioner as the Police Commissioner may, by order in writing, specify in this behalf.

(2) The appointment of subordinate officers shall be made in such manner and on such terms and conditions as may be prescribed.

(3) Every subordinate officer shall, on appointment, receive a certificate in the form set out in Schedule II under the seal and signature of the Police Commissioner or of the superior officer making the appointment.

(4) A certificate of appointment shall be cancelled whenever the person named therein ceases to belong to the Force and shall remain inoperative during the period of his suspension from the Force’.

5. **Amendment of section 9, Ord. III of 1976.**—In the said Ordinance, in section 9, after the words “constituted under this Ordinance”, the commas and words “, and on such transfer such police-officer shall, for all purposes, be deemed to be a police-officer appointed under the law under which the police-force to which he is transferred is constituted” shall be inserted.

6. **Amendment of section 12, Ord. III of 1976.**—In the said Ordinance, in section 12,—

(a) in sub-section (1), the commas and words “, or any other superior officer authorised by him in this behalf,” shall be omitted;

(b) after sub-section (1) amended as aforesaid, the following new sub-section shall be *inserted*, namely:—

“(1A) The power of punishment conferred on the Police Commissioner by sub-section (1) may also be exercisable, in the case of any subordinate officer other than an Inspector, by any superior officer not below the rank of Deputy Police Commissioner.”; and

(c) sub-section (4) shall be *omitted*.

7. **Insertion of new section 19A, Ord. III of 1976.**—In the said Ordinance, after section 19, the following new section shall be *inserted*, namely:—

“19A. **Power of police-officers to lay information, etc.**—A police-officer may lay any information before a Magistrate and apply for any legal process as may by law issue against any person committing an offence.”.

8. **Insertion of new section 93A, Ord. III of 1976.**—In the said Ordinance, after section 93, the following new section shall be *inserted*, namely:—

“93A. **Penalty for selling admission tickets at higher price.**—Whoever sells or offers for sale any ticket once issued for admission as spectator to any place of public amusement at a price higher than the price at which such ticket was originally issued shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three months, or with fine which may extend to five hundred taka, or with both.”.

9. **Insertion of new section 103A, Ord. III of 1976.**—In the said Ordinance, in Chapter VIII, before section 104, the following new section shall be *inserted*, namely:—

“103A. **Requisitioning of vehicles.**—(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law for the time being in force, the Police Commissioner may, by order in writing, requisition any vehicle, for a period not exceeding seven days, if such vehicle is required in public interest.

(2) Whenever any vehicle is requisitioned under sub-section (1), the owner thereof shall be paid such compensation as may be prescribed.”.

10. **Insertion of new section 105A, Ord. III of 1976.**—In the said Ordinance, after section 105, the following new section shall be *inserted*, namely:—

“105A. **Limitation of legal proceedings.**—Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law for the time being in force, any legal proceeding, whether civil or criminal, which may lawfully be brought against any police-officer for anything done or intended to be done under any provision of this Ordinance or of the rules, regulations or orders made thereunder, shall be commenced within six months after the act complained of has been committed, and a notice, in writing, of such proceeding and of the cause thereof shall be given to the police-officer concerned and his superior officer at least one month before the commencement of such proceeding.”.

11. **Amendment of Schedule II, Ord. III of 1976.**—In the said Ordinance, in Schedule II, for the words “Police Commissioner” the words “Appointing Authority” shall be *substituted*.

12. Amendment of certain laws.—The laws specified in column 3 of the Schedule to this Ordinance shall be amended in the manner specified in column 4 of that Schedule.

(২) কনস্টবল নং ২৪৮৭ জাহাঙ্গীর আলম, এস, এ, এফ, চট্টগ্রাম।

যে সাহসিকতাপূর্ণ কার্যের জন্য পদক প্রদান করা হয়েছে তার সংক্ষিপ্ত বিবরণ নিম্নে উল্লেখ করা হলঃ

সশস্ত্র পুলিশ বাহিনীর শিক্ষানবিশ ডেপুটি পুলিশ সুপার জনাব হাবিবুর রহমান (শহীদ)।

বিগত ২০শে জুলাই, ১৯৭৬ তারিখ রাত্রে পার্বত্য চট্টগ্রামের নাইখংছড়ি থানা এলাকায় কিছু সংখ্যক সশস্ত্র দক্ষতাকারীর বিরুদ্ধে চট্টগ্রামের সশস্ত্র পুলিশ বাহিনী, আর, আর এফ, এবং চট্টগ্রাম ও পার্বত্য চট্টগ্রামের জেলা পুলিশ, শিক্ষানবিশ ডি, এস, পি, জনাব হাবিবুর রহমানের নেতৃত্বে এক সম্মিলিত অভিযান পরিচালনা করেন।

হেডম্যানপাড়া নামক স্থান থেকে পুলিশ বাহিনী ১৬ জন দক্ষতাকারীকে গ্রেফতার করে। এ-সব দক্ষতাকারীকে জিজ্ঞাসাবাদ করে জানা যায় যে ৪ মাইল দূরবর্তী জুমখোলা নামক স্থানে সশস্ত্র দক্ষতাকারীদের একটি গোপন আড্ডা আছে। সম্মিলিত পুলিশ বাহিনী পায়ে হেঁটে এ ৪ মাইল বিপদসংকুল পথ গভীর অরণ্যের ভিতর দিয়ে অতিক্রম করে এবং উল্লিখিত গোপন আড্ডার কাছাকাছি এসে পড়ে। পুলিশ বাহিনীর উপস্থিতি টের পেয়ে দক্ষতাকারীগণ স্বয়ংক্রিয় ও শক্তিশালী আশেনাস্ত্রের সাহায্যে পুলিশ বাহিনীকে আক্রমণ করে। শিক্ষানবিশ ডি, এস, পি, জনাব হাবিবুর রহমান তাঁর সংগীয় পুলিশ বাহিনীকে পালাটা আক্রমণ করতে উৎসাহিত করেন এবং তিনি স্বয়ং শত্রুদের লক্ষ্য করে গুলি ছুঁড়তে থাকেন। কিছুক্ষণ গুলি বিনিময়ের পর দুটি বুলেট তাঁর উরুতে এবং তলপেটে এসে লাগে। তিনি আপন পরিধেয় বস্ত্র ছিঁড়ে ক্ষতস্থান বেঁধে ফেলেন এবং দক্ষতাকারীদের লক্ষ্য করে গুলি বর্ষণ অব্যাহত রাখেন। এর কিছুক্ষণ পরে জনাব হাবিবুর রহমান মৃত্যুবরণ করেন।

অসমসাহসিকতা, বীরত্ব ও বলিষ্ঠ নেতৃত্বের জন্য জনাব হাবিবুর রহমানকে “বাংলাদেশ পুলিশ পদক” (মরণোত্তর) প্রদান করা হল।

চট্টগ্রাম জেলার কনস্টবল ২৪৮৭ জাহাঙ্গীর আলম।

পার্বত্য চট্টগ্রাম জেলার নাইখংছড়ি থানা এলাকায় কিছু সংখ্যক সশস্ত্র দক্ষতাকারীর অবস্থানের সংবাদ পেয়ে বিগত ২০শে জুলাই, ১৯৭৬ তারিখে সশস্ত্র পুলিশ বাহিনী, আর, আর, এফ, এবং পার্বত্য চট্টগ্রাম জেলা পুলিশ এক সম্মিলিত অভিযান পরিচালনা করে। এ সম্মিলিত বাহিনী হেডম্যানপাড়া নামক স্থান থেকে ১৬ জন দক্ষতাকারীকে গ্রেফতার করে। এ-সব দক্ষতাকারীকে জিজ্ঞাসাবাদ করে জানা যায় যে হেডম্যানপাড়া থেকে ৪ মাইল দূরবর্তী জুমখোলা নামক স্থানে সশস্ত্র দক্ষতাকারীদের একটি গোপন আড্ডা আছে। সম্মিলিত পুলিশ বাহিনী পায়ে হেঁটে এ ৪ মাইল বিপদসংকুল পথ গভীর অরণ্যের মধ্যে দিয়ে অতিক্রম করে



উল্লিখিত গোপন আন্ডার কাছাকাছি এসে পড়ে। পুলিশ বাহিনীর উপস্থিতি টের পেয়ে দক্ষতীকারীগণ স্বয়ংক্রিয় ও শক্তিশালী আন্দোলনের সাহায্যে পুলিশ বাহিনীকে আক্রমণ করে। চট্টগ্রাম জেলার কং ২৪৮৭ জাহাঙ্গীর আলম নিজের রাইফেল থেকে দক্ষতীকারীদের দিকে পাল্টা গুলি ছুঁড়তে আরম্ভ করেন এবং দক্ষতীকারীদের দিকে অগ্রসর হতে থাকেন। কিন্তু দক্ষতীকারীদের একটি বুলেট তাঁর মস্তক ভেদ করে চলে যায় এবং তিনি সঙ্গে সঙ্গে মৃত্যুবরণ করেন।
