The following corrections in the Import Policy (July-December, 1975) Order, as published in the *Bangladesh Gazette, Extraordinary*, dated July 2, 1975, are notified for the information of all concerned:

- (1) In footnote of paragraph 26 (c) the following sentence shall be added:—
“In case of exports by post parcel percentage of entitlement for the purpose of licensing under this scheme shall be calculated on C & F basis”.
- (2) In paragraph 30 the names of 61 districts under the column “Districts with effect from 1-9-75” and the word “existing” in column 2 (two) shall be *deleted*.
- (3) (i) In List-1 and Annexure III (A) under column 3 against the description of item at serial No. 20 the number “87/12” shall be *inserted*.
(ii) Under column 3 against the description of item at serial No. 28 in List-1 and Annexure III (A) the number “82/44” shall be *deleted*.
- (4) In Annexure I Priority List-1 under chemical group—after serial number 57 the following shall be *added*:—

57B	...	Vermicelli (Semai).

- (5) In Annexure VIII of both English and Bengali version of the Import Policy (July-December, 1975) Order, *after* serial No. 35 *insert* the following at column "1,2 & 3" respectively:—

36 ... Tea in packets (w.e.f. 1-7-75) ... 25%.

The existing serial No. 36 shall be *re-numbered* as 37.

O. 318-L/75/255/D/Cus/75.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Government is pleased to exempt such industrial raw materials (not packing materials and spares) enumerated in Annexure II in the Import Policy (July-December, 1975) Order, as are imported by a Bangladesh national earning foreign exchange abroad or consigned by him to a Bangladesh national from the whole of the Customs duties leviable thereon subject to the following conditions:—

- (i) the consignee of the raw materials must be a recognised industrial unit holding valid import registration certificate and the industry is listed in the Priority List I or II of the Annexure I attached to the said Order;
- (ii) the industries listed in Priority List No. I or II of the Annexure I shall, respectively, be permitted to import industrial raw materials listed in the Annexure II up to 100% and 50% of the Half Yearly Entitlement for each item as recorded in the Pass Book;
- (iii) for the purpose of verification, the Pass Book showing the Entitlement shall be produced to the officer of Customs along with other relevant documents at the time of Customs clearance;
- (iv) industrial raw materials so imported shall not be utilised for any purpose other than the production of goods for which the industrial unit holds the aforesaid Entitlement; and
- (v) the industrial raw materials are booked for import during July-December Shipping Period of 1975.

NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 29th August 1975.

No. S.R.O. 319-L/75/250/D/Cus/75.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of section 21 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to authorize repayment to the extent specified in column (3) of the table below of Customs duties paid on the importation of the raw materials specified in column (1) of the said table and used in the production or manufacture of the goods specified in column (2) thereof, subject to the following conditions, namely:—

- (i) The goods have been manufactured according to the formula duly furnished to the National Board of Revenue showing the quantity of various imported raw materials specified in column (1) of the said table and used in the production or manufacture of the goods specified in column (2) thereof.
- (ii) The manufacturer maintains proper record of the goods manufactured in accordance with the formula referred to in sub-paragraph (i) and produces, on demand, such records and other evidence as may be required by the National Board of Revenue to satisfy itself that the imported raw materials have been used in accordance with the formula.
- (iii) The manufactured goods are exported out of Bangladesh and an application for repayment of Customs duties is presented to the proper officer of Customs within 60 days of such exportation or of the publication of this notification, whichever is the later.
- (iv) The exporter makes a declaration on the reverse of the original shipping bill or other export documents to the effect that he would claim repayment of the customs duties paid on the imported raw materials used in the production of the goods being exported.
- (v) The repayment at the rate specified shall be allowed provided that the goods exported are manufactured with the same constituents on which the rate of repayment is notified and the manufacturer-cum-exporter shall immediately intimate to the National Board of Revenue and the Directorate of Inspection and Training (Customs and Excise), Dacca:—
 - (a) any change in the process of the imported raw materials,
 - (b) any changes in the composition of the manufactured goods to be exported, and
 - (c) use of any indigenous raw materials in place of the imported raw materials.

2. The repayment authorized by this notification shall be admissible in respect of the goods exported on or before 29th May, 1975.
