No. S.R.O. 400-L/76/317/D/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Sales Tax Act, 1951 (III of 1951), the Government is pleased to exempt such of the goods as have already been imported into the territories of erstwhile East Pakistan under the contract signed before the 16th December, 1971 by M/s. Vinnel-Zachry-Perini under US AID grant and certified by the National Board of Revenue to be the goods required for the construction of bridges in the Dacca-Aricha Highway from the whole of customs-duties chargeable thereon and from the whole of the tax payable under the aforesaid Sales Tax Act, 1951.
