Dhaka, the 23rd October, 1986

No. S.R.O. 415.L/86/MVRT/1A-1/85(Part-I).—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 50 of the Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1983 (LV of 1983), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Motor Vehicles Rules, 1984, the same having been previously published as required by sub-section (1) of section 173 of the said Ordinance, namely:

In the aforesaid Rules, for rule 72, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

- "72. Exemption from certificate of fitness.—The certificate of fitness referred to in section 47 shall not apply to—
 - (a) a two wheeled motor cycle other than that used for hire or reward; and
 - (b) any motor vehicle constructed or adapted or used for carrying not more than eight persons including the driver, not being a transport vehicle, for the first five years of its manufacture.

Explanation.—The date of manufacture of a vehicle shall be counted from the 1st day of January of the respective year.".
