NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 3rd November 1986

No. S.R.O. 421-L/86.—The following draft of certain further amendment to the rules framed under the Poisons Act, 1919 (XII of 1919), published under the late Government of Bengal Home Department Notification No. 5303-PI, dated the 12th December 1931, which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 and section 8 of the Poisons Act, 1919 (XII of 1919), is hereby published as required by sub-section (2) of section 8 of the said Act for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the draft will be taken into consideration on or after a period of one month from the date of publication of this Notification in the official Gazette. Any objection or suggestion which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft within the said period will be considered by the Government:

**Draft Amendment**

In the aforesaid Rules, in Schedule II, *after* entry 14, the following new entries shall be *added*, namely:—

15. Concentrated Sulphuric Acid.
16. Concentrated Hydrochloric Acid.
17. Glacial Acetic Acid.
18. Strong solution of Ammonia (Liquor Ammonia Fort's).
19. Concentrated lye of Caustic Soda.
20. Concentrated lye of Caustic Potash.”
