In the aforesaid Schedule, in Part V, for the entries relating to the Port of Chalna, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

Note: A. Entry takes place when the vessel enters into the Port of Chaina limits.

Note: B. Where two gross tonnage are assigned to certain vessels in association with a tonnage mark on the vessels' side the higher figure shall be applicable in determining gross tonnage for the purpose of assessment of port dues;

Note: C. For calculating the dues payable by a vessel the weight of the deck cargo (in metric ton) shall be added to its GRT (Gross Registered Tonnage).

Note: D. Payment of port dues shall be received in Bangladesh currency calculated at the official rate of exchange (selling) on the date of arrival of the vessel at the Port of Chalna and if the arrival date of the vessel coincides with any holiday and for that reason official rate of exchange is not available, the rate of exchange on the succeeding date shall be taken into consideration for assessment of port dues."

- Conditions: (i) Fees both for inward and outward pilotage shall be levied as per above Table subject to a minimum of US \$ 400.00 for each inward or outward Pilotage.
 - (ii) If Pilotage work takes place wholly or in part between 6.00 R.M. and 6.00 a.m. a fee at the rate of 1½ times of the pilotage fee specified above shall be levied.
 - (iii) Where two GRT are assigned to a vessel in association with a tonnage mark on the vessels' side, the higher figure shall be applicable in determining GRT for the purpose of assessment of pilotage fees.
 - (iv) Payment of fees shall be received in Bangladesh currency calculated at the official rate of exchange (selling) on the date of arrival of the vessel at the Port of Chalna and if the arrival date of the vessel coincides with any holiday and for that reason official rate of exchange is not available, the rate of exchange on the succeeding date shall be taken into consideration for assessment of the pilotage fees.

(v) The allowance for Pilots Extra Pilotage, Inward or Outward Pilotage, Mooring, Night Pilotage are included in the Pilotage fees.
