No. S.R.O. 441-L/86/1044/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 21 (b) of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and section 5A of the Sales Tax Ordinance, 1982 (XVIII of 1982), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to authorise the delivery of the goods specified in the Schedule below imported by the Department of Fisheries and private aquaculturist without payment of the whole of the customs-duties and the sales tax chargeable thereon subject to the condition that the said goods shall be used in the processing of

hatchery and production of shrimp and fish and a certificate from the Department of Fisheries is produced before the concerned Collector of Customs to that effect:
