

No. S. R. O. 452-L/76/29-Excise.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3A of the Excises and Salt Act, 1944 (I of 1944), the Government is pleased to make the following amendment in this Ministry's hotification No. S.R.O. 295-L/76/18-Excise, dated the 25th August, 1976, nancity:—
