O. 6-L/80/516/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and sub-section (2) of section 7 of the Sales Tax Act, 1951 (III of 1951), and in supersession of its notification No. S.R.O. 334-L/79/510/Cus., dated the 5th December 1979, the Government is pleased to exempt electric filament lamps falling under Heading No. 85.20A of the First Schedule to the Tariff Act, 1934 (XXXII of 1934) from so much of customs-duty and sales tax as is in excess of 25% *ad valorem* and 20%, respectively, provided that these are imported under the Wage Earner Scheme.
