NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 19th January 1983

No. S.R.O. 23-L/89/1G-1/D-21/82.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 6 of the Air Force Act, 1953 (VI of 1953), and in supersession of the erstwhile Government of Pakistan Notification No. 1964/65, dated the 8th October, 1965, the Government is pleased—

- (a) to direct that the classes of persons mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto annexed, when subject to the said Act under clause (d) of section 2 thereof, shall be so subject as the class of persons mentioned in the corresponding entry in the second column of the said Schedule; and
- (b) to authorise the officer commanding any force in the field to give a like direction with respect to any person accompanying such force,

other than a Government servant when subject to the said Act under clause (d) of section 2 thereof, and to cancel such direction.

Schedule

Categories of civilian personnel employed in Bangladesh Air Force.	Relative Rank.
(a) All Gazetted Officers (Civilian)	Commissioned Officers.
(b) Those whose maximum rate in the pay of their present grade is over Tk. 650·00 per month.	Master Warrant Officers and Warrant Officers.
(c) Those whose maximum rate in the pay scale of their present grade is Taka 435·00 and above but less than Taka 650·00 per month.	Non-Commissioned Officers.
