ORDER

Dacca, the 11th January 1982

No. S.R.O. 29-L/82/5(1)/82.—Whereas the workers of the Bangladesh Jute Marketing Corporation, Narayanganj, have gone on strike with effect from the 7th December, 1981;

And whereas the said strike has lasted for more than thirty days ;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 32 of the Industrial Relations Ordinance, 1969 (XXIII of 1969), the Government is pleased to prohibit the said strike of the workers of the Bangladesh Jute Marketing Corporation and to refer their dispute to the Third Labour Court, Dacca, for adjudication in pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (3) of that section.
