NOTIFICATIONS

Dacca, the 5th February, 1976.

No. S.R.O. 52-L/76.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 17 of the Forest Act, 1927 (XVI of 1927), the Government is pleased to appoint the Commissioner, Chittagong Division, to be the officer who shall hear appeals from the orders passed by the Forest Settlement Officer under section 11, 12, 15 or 16 of the said Act.

No. S.R.O. 53-L/76.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (a) and (b) of sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Forest Act, 1927 (XVI of 1927), the Government is pleased to declare that it has been decided to constitute a reserved forest with the lands described in the Schedule below.

The Government is further pleased to appoint under clause (c) of sub-section (1) and sub-section (3) of section 4 of the said Act, the Deputy Commissioner, Sylhet and the Divisional Forest Officer, Sylhet Division, to be the Forest Settlement Officers who shall, under the provisions of Chapter II of the said Act, enquire into and determine the existence, nature and extent of any rights alleged

to exist in favour of any person in or over any land comprised within the boundaries specified in the Schedule below or in or over any forest-produce, and to deal with the same as provided in the said Chapter:
