NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 15th February, 1983.

No. S.R.O. 79-L/83/ED/Recruitment/1-15/80(Pt-IV).—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Chief Martial Law Administrator, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following amendment in the Bangladesh Civil Service (Age, Qualification and Examination for Direct Recruitment) Rules, 1982, namely:—

In the aforesaid rules, in rule 20, for sub-rule (1) shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) The minimum pass marks shall be 45% in the aggregate in written examination, 40% in viva-voce test, and 40% in the psychology and intelligence tests:

Provided that, if necessary, the Commission may, with the prior approval of the Government, lower or enhance the minimum aggregate pass marks or pass marks, as the case may be.”
