NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 16th February, 1983

No. S.R.O. 81-I/83/766/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (7) of section 25 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Government is pleased to fix the tariff value of those cotton fabrics shown in column (1) (which arrived at the customs port on or before 31st December 1982 only against letter of credit opened or established before 30th June 1982, and lying uncleared) as shown in column (2) of the Table below:—

No. S.R.O. 82-L/83/ST.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Sales Tax Ordinance, 1982 (Ord. XVIII of 1982), the Government is pleased to make the following amendment in this Ministry's Notification No. S.R.O. 40-L/83/ST., dated the 1st of February, 1983, namely:—

In the aforesaid Notification, in the Table, in column (2), for the word "other" the word "otter" shall be substituted and shall be deemed to have been so substituted on the 1st of February, 1983.

## (Excise)

## NOTIFICATIONS

Dhaka, the 16th February, 1983.

No. S.R.O. 83-L/83/Excise.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 12A of the Excise and Salt Act, 1944 (I of 1944), the Government is pleased to exempt one thousand three hundred twenty-six units of Truck chassis and six hundred seventy-eight units of Bus chassis now in the stock of M/s. Progoti Industries Limited, Chittagong, assessable under Item No.11-10 of the First Schedule to the said Act, from payment of so much of excise duty as is in excess of 5% *ad. valorem* on the following conditions, namely:—

- (a) 20% of the duty so assessed will be paid at the time of clearance;
- (b) Rest 80% of the excise duty shall be paid in 24 equal monthly instalments;
- (c) Bangladesh Steel and Engineering Corporation shall give an undertaking to the effect that in case M/s. Progoti Industries Limited fails to pay up the full amount of excise duty, they will pay it up themselves.

No. S.R.O. 84-L/83/Excise.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 12A of the Excises and Salt Act, 1944 (I of 1944), the Government is pleased to exempt diesel oil, Kerosene, Motor Spirit and petroleum lubricating oil falling under Item Numbers 03-07, 03-09, 03-10 and 03-13 respectively of the First Schedule to the said Act from the payment of the whole of excise duty leviable thereon when exclusively used by the International Centre for Diarrhoeal Disease Research, Bangladesh (ICDDR, B), Dhaka on the following conditions, namely:—

- (i) the International Centre for Diarrhoeal Disease Research, Bangladesh, shall purchase the required quantities of the aforesaid Petroleum, Oil and Lubricants products direct from the oil company M/s. Meghna Petroleum Limited, Chittagone on requisition in writing against payment in foreign currency only;

- (ii) the POL products, to be so purchased by the International Centre for Diarrhoeal Disease Research, Bangladesh, shall not be sold to any buyer whether employed by the Centre or not and shall be used exclusively by the Centre;
- (iii) the International Centre for Diarrhoeal Disease Research, Bangladesh, shall submit a half-yearly return to the Collector of Customs and Excise, Chittagong, showing the quantities of POL products consumed, their value in Taka and corresponding amount of foreign currency paid. Copies of such returns shall also be endorsed to the Assistant Collector or Deputy Collector, Chittagong Division-2, and the Superintendent of Customs and Excise, Chittagong Circle-IV, Assistant Collector or Deputy Collector, Customs and Excise, Narayanganj and Superintendent of Customs and Excise, Narayanganj.
