No. S.R.O. 81-L/80/258/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred under section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Government is pleased to direct that 'Shoe Tacks' falling within the Heading number 73·31 of the First Schedule to the Tariff Act, 1934 (XXXII of 1934), shall be exempt from so much of the customs duties leviable thereon as is in excess of 50% per cent ad valorem.

No. S.R.O. 85-L/80/LIWVII/14(5)/78.—Whereas the Government is of the opinion that all classes of employment under the Bangladesh Bank, Sonali Bank, Janata Bank, Agrani Bank, Pubali Bank, Rupali Bank, Uttara Bank, Bangladesh Krishi Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Rin Sangstha, Investment Corporation of Bangladesh and House Building Finance Corporation are essential for maintaining services necessary to the life of the community;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Essential Services (Second) Ordinance, 1958 (E. P. Ord, XLI of 1958), the Government is pleased to declare that all classes of employment under the Bangladesh Bank, Sonali Bank, Janata Bank, Agrani Bank, Pubali Bank, Rupali Bank, Uttara Bank, Bangladesh Krishi Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Rin Sangstha, Investment Corporation of Bangnadesh and House Building Finance Corporation to be classes of employment to which the said Ordinance applies.
