

#### NOTIFICATION

#### Dhaka, the 1st March, 1983

- No. S. R. O. 97-L/83/ED(JA-II)/193/77(Pt. I).—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Chief Martial Law Administrator is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—
- 1. Short title.—These rules may be called the Thana Revenue Officers' Recruitment Rules, 1983.
- 2. Definitions.—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context:—
  - (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to the post;
  - (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
  - (c) "probationer" means a person appointed on probation to the post of Thana Revenue Officer;
  - (d) "post" means the post of Thana Revenue Officer; and
  - (e) "recognised University" means a University established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other University declared by the Government, after consultation with the Commission to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules.

- 3. Procedure for recruitment.—(1) Appointment to the post shall be made-
  - (a) 50% by direct recruitment; and
  - (b) 50% by promotion from amongst Subdivisional Managers of Government Acquired Estates, Revenue Circle Officers (Collection), Settlement Kanungos, Field Kanungos and District Kanungos.
- (2) No person shall be appointed to the post unless, in the case of promotion, he has five years of service in a feeder post or posts concerned and, in the case of direct appointment, he has a Bachelor's degree (preferably, in Second Division/Class) from a recognised University and his age is not exceeding 25 years.
- 4. Appointment by direct recruitment.—(1) No appointment to the post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.
- (2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by direct recruitment, if he—
  - (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in, Bangladesh; and
  - (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.
  - (3) No appointment to the post by direct recruitment shall be made until-
    - (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director-General of Health Services to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the post; and
    - (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.
  - (4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to the post unless-
    - (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the post; and
    - (b) in the case a person already in Government service or in the service of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.
- Appointment by promotion.—(1) Appointment by promotion to the post shall be made on the recommendation of the Commission.
- (2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to the post if he has unsatisfactory records of service.
- 6. Probation.—(1) Person selected for appointment to the post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation,—
  - (a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and
  - (b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment:

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

- (2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period:-
  - (a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
  - (b) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.
- (3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority,-
  - (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and
  - (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory may,-
    - (i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
    - (ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.
- (4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in the post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, direct by order.

## PROCLAMATION Martial Law Case No. 15/83

Whereas it has been made to appear to me that the accused Md. Yaquab Hossain, son of late Hakim Uddin of 41/A. Purana Paltan, Motijheel, Dhaka, present address: 169/12, East Rampura, P.S. Gulshan, Dist, Dhaka, is required for the purpose of trial in the Summary Martial Law Court No. 2:

And whereas the Court has reason to believe that the said accused Md. Yaquab Hossain, son of late Hakim Uddin, in the case abovementioned, is absconding or concealing himself to avoid appearance or arrest for the said purpose;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Regulation 2(11) of the Martial Law Regulation No. I of 1982, this Summary Martial Law Court No. 2, do hereby direct the aforesaid accused person to appear in this Court at 0900 hours on 17th March 1983 in Summary Martial Law Court No. 2, Case No. ML 15/83, failing which he will be tried in absentia and his properties, both moveable and immoveable, may be forfeited to the Government.
