No. S. R. O. 107-L/80/230-Ans.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 3 of the Ansars Act, 1948 (E. B. Act VII of 1948), and in supersession of the Police and Ansars Department Notification No. 406-PL(III)/PIOA-69/68, dated the 14th June, 1969, the Government is pleased to delegate its powers under sub-section (1) of section 4 of the said Act to the District Magistrates within their respective jurisdictions to make order for embodiment of Ansars into the Police Force.

No. S.R.O. 108-L/80/231-Ans.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Ansars Act, 1948 (E.B. Act VII of 1948), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Ansars Rules, 1948, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules,—

(a) in rule 3, for the words “the Dacca” occurring twice the letter “a” shall be *substituted* in both the places;

(b) for rule 4A the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“4A. In a Metropolitan Area, the Assistant Police Commissioner shall be *ex-officio* Deputy Commandant of Ansars within his jurisdiction.

4B. A Circle Officer (Development) shall be *ex-officio* Assistant Commandant of Ansars within his jurisdiction.”;

(c) in rule 22, in clause (a) after the words, commas, figures and brackets “the Dacca Metropolitan Police Ordinance, 1976 (Ord. III of 1976),” the words, commas, figures and brackets “or the Chittagong Metropolitan Police Ordinance, 1978 (Ord. XLVIII of 1978),” shall be *inserted*.

No. S.R.O. 109-L/80.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People’s Republic of Bangladesh, and in supersession of all other rules in this behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

THE NON-GAZETTED POSTS (RADIO BANGLADESH) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1980

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the non-Gazetted posts (Radio Bangladesh) Recruitment Rules, 1980.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) “Appointing Authority” means the Government and includes, in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to such post or class of posts;
- (b) “Commission” means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (c) “Probationer” means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (d) “Recognised University” means a university established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other university declared by the Government, after consultation with the Commission, to be a recognised university for the purpose of these rules;
- (e) “Recognised Board” means a Board established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other Board declared by the Government, to be a recognised Board for the purposes of these rules;
- (f) “Requisite qualification” in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the schedule in relation to that post;
- (g) “Schedule” means the schedule annexed to these rules; and
- (h) “Specified post” means a post specified in the schedule.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and instructions relating to reservation for the purpose of clause (3) of article 29 of the Constitution of the People’s Republic of Bangladesh, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment; or
- (b) by promotion.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and, in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit laid down in the schedule for that post.

4. **Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission or in such cases as the Government specifies in this behalf, the Departmental Selection Committee appointed for this purpose.

- (2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—
 - (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh;

provided that this clause shall not apply in the case of a person who is already in the service of the Republic;
 - (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made, until—

(a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Officer competent to issue medical certificate in terms of rule 14 of the Service Rules, Part I, to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and

(b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post, unless—

(a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission or the Departmental Selection Committee, as the case may be, while inviting applications for the specified post; and

(b) in the case of a person already in Government service or in the service of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.

5. **Appointment by promotion.**—(1) Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made on the recommendation of such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may constitute in this behalf:

Provided that appointment by promotion to a specified post of higher class shall be made on the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post if he has unsatisfactory records of service.

6. **Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post against a permanent vacancy shall be appointed on probation—

(a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and

(b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such an appointment :

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period not exceeding two years in the aggregate.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may before the expiry of that period—

(a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and

(b) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority,—

(a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and

(b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may,—

(i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and

(ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, direct.
