No. S.R.O. 110-L/81/ICMA/Ex-10/63/81.—The following draft of certain further amendments which the Council of the Institute of Cost and Management Accountants of Bangladesh, with the approval of the Government, proposes to make in the Cost and Management Accountants Regulations, 1980, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 31 of the Cost and Management accountants Ordinance, 1977 (LIII of 1977), is hereby published, as required by sub-section (3) of the said section, for the information of all persons likely to be affected and notice is hereby given that the draft will be taken into consideration on or after 30th April, 1981.

Any objection or suggestion with respect to the said draft which may be received from any person before the date specified will be considered by the Council.

DRAFT AMENDMENTS

In the aforesaid Regulations, in regulation 84, in clause (b), the word “and” at the end shall be *omitted* and *after* clause (b), amended as aforesaid, the following new clause shall be *inserted*, namely:—

“(bb) he is a teacher of a University established by law for the time being in force and has passed the course of the Institute of Cost and Management Accountants of Bangladesh and has also at least three years teaching experience in accounting subjects; and”.

Dacca, the 9th April 1981

No. S.R.O. 111-L/81/632/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and section 7 of the Sales-tax Act, 1951 (III of 1951), and in supersession of this Ministry's Notifications Nos. SRO. 149-L/77/342/D/Cus., dated the 14th May 1977 and SRO. 244-L/78/447/D/Cus., dated the 18th September 1978, the Government is pleased to exempt the articles falling under the Tariff Heading of the First Schedule to the Customs Act, 1969, specified in Table-I and imported for

installation in the territorial area specified in Column (1) of Part 'A' of Table-II below or for installation under such conditions or for such purposes as are specified in Column (1) of Part 'B' of Table-II, from so much of Customs-duties leviable thereon as is in excess of the rates specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) of Table-II and from the whole of the sales-tax leviable thereon provided the articles are machinery as defined hereunder or spare parts of or articles for use with, such machinery, subject to the following conditions, namely:—

- (i) The exemption granted under this Notification shall apply to—
 - (a) the machinery imported for initial installation of an industrial unit or for balancing, modernization, replacement or expansion of an existing unit as sanctioned by the competent sanctioning authority and certified by the Director-General, Department of Industries for private sector industries and by an authorised officer not below the rank of Joint Secretary of the Ministry concerned for public sector industries, in the form appended in Annex-I;
 - (b) the spare parts of, or the articles for use with, machinery valued up to 10 per cent of the value of the machinery and imported along with such machinery;
 - (c) only such spare parts of, or the articles which are identifiable for use with, machinery and have been given for that purpose some special shape, size or quality;
 - (ii) It is established to the satisfaction of an officer of Customs not below the rank of Assistant Collector of Customs that the exemption herein granted is admissible; and
 - (iii) No customs duty has been imposed on the articles under the Protective Duties Act, 1950 (LXI of 1950), nor has the customs duty imposed on the articles been changed under the said act into protective.
2. For the purpose of this Notification, the term "machinery" shall mean—
- (i) machinery, operated by power of any description, such as is used in any industrial process, including the generation, transmission and distribution of power, or used in processes directly connected with the extraction of minerals and timber, construction of buildings, roads, dams, bridges and similar structures and in the manufacture of goods;
 - (ii) an appropriate quantum of apparatus and appliances specially adapted for use in conjunction with machinery specified in items(i);
 - (iii) an appropriate quantum of metering and testing apparatus and appliances required for use along with the machinery specified in item(i);
 - (iv) an appropriate quantum of mechanical and electrical control and transmission gear adapted for use in conjunction with machinery specified in item (i); and
 - (v) an appropriate quantum of component parts, as distinct from spare parts, of articles specified in items (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) identifiable as for use in or with such machinery.

- (c) An industry which would use not less than 70% indigenous raw materials in value for its manufactured products and to that effect a certificate from the Director-General, Department of Industries for the private sector industries and by an officer not below the rank of Joint Secretary of the concerned Ministry for public sector industries is produced and an undertaking is furnished at the time of clearance of the machinery by the importer in the form appended in Annex-III binding himself to pay the customs duty and sales tax leviable thereon had this concession not been allowed, if it is proved on the certification of the Collector of Customs of the territorial jurisdiction that the industrial unit in question failed to use at least 70% indigenous raw materials for its products .. 2½% *ad val.*
- (d) An industry the machinery of which have been imported under Wage Earner Scheme 5% *ad val.*

NATIONAL BOARD OF REVENUE

(Customs) *

NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 9th April, 1981

No. S.R.O. 113-L/81/631/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 219 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), read with item 17 of the Third Schedule thereof, and in supersession of all other rules made in this behalf, the National Board of Revenue is pleased to make the following rules, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Tourists Baggage (Import) Rules, 1981.
- (2) They shall apply to those passengers who visit Bangladesh for a period of more than twenty-four hours and not more than six months and do not get engaged in any gainful or remunerative profession or calling in Bangladesh.

2. In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context, "baggage" means the personal wearing apparel and other personal effects which are not for sale and are exclusively imported for the personal use of the tourist.

3. A tourist may import free of duty the following goods on his person or in his baggage, namely :—

- (i) articles of wearing apparel and clothing accessories;
- (ii) handbags and travel goods;
- (iii) articles of metal (including medal, trophies or prizes) bestowed upon him as honorary distinction by foreign countries or citizens of foreign countries;
- (iv) personal jewellery or imitation jewellery in use, the value of which does not exceed Taka three thousand;
- (v) one watch and one travelling clock in use;
- (vi) other articles of personal adornment, toilet requisites including electric shaver in use;
- (vii) spectacles and other physical aids in use;
- (viii) one cigarette lighter, two fountain pens, one pen-knife and similar objects of personal use normally carried in the pocket, in the handbag or on the person;
- (ix) one electric smoothing iron, one portable electric hot plate, one hair dryer;
- (x) one photographic camera and 10 plates or 5 rolls of film;
- (xi) one cinematograph camera with projector and two rolls of films;
- (xii) one pair of binoculars;
- (xiii) one portable musical instrument;
- (xiv) one portable sound recording apparatus;
- (xv) one portable typewriter;

- (xvi) one invalid chair in use;
 - (xvii) one perambulator or go-cart and toys in reasonable quantity if in use of an accompanying child;
 - (xviii) games or sporting requisites in actual use including sporting fire arms and cartridges in reasonable quantity;
 - (xix) 200 cigarettes or 50 cigars or $\frac{1}{2}$ pound of manufactured tobacco or an assortment of cigarettes, cigars and manufactured tobacco not exceeding $\frac{1}{2}$ pound in weight;
 - (xx) two bottles of spirituous beverages weighing not more than 1/3rd of a gallon;
 - (xxi) perfumed spirits and toilet waters up to $\frac{1}{2}$ pint;
 - (xxii) foodstuffs including confectionery, and non spirituous beverages of value not exceeding Taka one hundred.
4. A tourist may also import free of duty goods which are in a reasonable number and quantity for making gifts or to give as souvenirs subject to the limit that the aggregate value of such goods does not exceed Taka five hundred only.
