No. S.R.O.119-L/80/1E-2/80/D-6.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 178 of the Navy Ordinance, 1961 (Ord. XXXV of 1961) the Government is pleased to make the following amendments in the Navy Uniforms Regulations, 1964, namely:—

In the aforesaid Regulations, in paragraph 184, in sub-paragraph (c),—

- (a) for item No. 4 in column A and the entries relating thereto in columns B, C, and D the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

- (b) for item Nos. 12 and 13 in column A and the entries relating thereto in columns B, C and D the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 13th May 1980.

No. S.R.O. 120-L/80/CAS-1/14(1)/74-Pt.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Civil Aviation Ordinance, 1960 (XXXII of 1960), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Aircraft Rules, 1937, the same having been previously published as required by sub-section (2) of section 15 of the said Ordinance, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules, in Schedule V, for Section C the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“Section C—Tariff of Route Navigation Facility Charges.

The charges for providing route air navigation facilities for overflying the territory of Bangladesh for international flight, including flights landing in Bangladesh shall be as follows:—

Maximum permissible all up weight of the aircraft.	Charges (in Bangladesh Taka).
Not exceeding 12,500 lbs.
Over 12,500 lbs. but not exceeding 90,000 lbs. 320·00
Over 90,000 lbs. but not exceeding 2,25,000 lbs. 480·00
Over 2,25,000 lbs. but not exceeding 3,15,000 lbs. 640·00
3,15,001 lbs. and over 1,280·00”.
