ORDER

Dacca, the 27th May 1980

No. S.R.O. 146-L/80/545/D/Cus/80.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of section 21 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to authorize repayment to the extent specified in column (3) of the table below of the Customs Duties paid on the importation of the raw materials specified in column (1) of the said table and used in the production or manufacture of the goods specified in column (2) thereof, subject to the following conditions, namely:—

- (i) The goods have been manufactured according to the formula duly furnished to the National Board of Revenue showing the quantity of various imported raw materials specified in column (1) of the said table and used in the production or manufacture of the goods specified in column (2) thereof;
- (ii) The manufacturer maintains proper record of the goods manufactured in accordance with the formula referred to in sub-paragraph (i) and produces, on demand, such records and other evidence as may be required by the National Board of Revenue to satisfy itself that the imported raw materials have been used in accordance with the formula;

- (iii) The manufactured goods are exported out of Bangladesh and an application for repayment of Customs duties is presented to the proper officer of Customs within 60 days of such exportation or of the publication of the Order, whichever is later;
- (iv) The exporter makes a declaration on the reverse of the original shipping bill or other export documents to the effect that he would claim repayment of the Customs duties paid on the imported raw materials used in the production of the goods being exported; and
- (v) The repayment at the rate specified shall be allowed provided that the goods exported are manufactured with the same constituents on which the rate of repayment is ordered and the manufacturer-*cum*-exporter shall immediately intimate to the National Board of Revenue and the Directorate of Inspection and Training (Customs and Excise), Dacca—
- (a) any change in the process of the imported raw materials,
- (b) any changes in the composition of the manufactured goods to be exported, and
- (c) use of any indigenous raw material in place of the imported raw materials.

2. The repayment authorized by this order shall be admissible in respect of the goods exported on or after the 12th September 1979.

## NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 30th May, 1979

**No. S.R.O. 148-L/80.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, and in supersession of all rules made in this behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

THE RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POSTS OF PRINCIPAL AND OTHER TEACHERS OF ENGINEERING COLLEGES UNDER THE DIRECTORATE OF TECHNICAL EDUCATION, BANGLADESH, 1979.

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called "The Recruitment Rules for the Posts of Principal and other Teachers of Engineering Colleges under the Directorate of Technical Education, Bangladesh, 1979".

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to such post or class of posts;
- (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (c) "Probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (d) "recognised university" means a university established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other university declared by the Government, after consultation with the Commission, to be a recognised university for the purpose of these rules;

- (e) "requisite qualification" in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (f) "Schedule" means the schedule annexed to these rules; and
- (g) "Specified Post" means a post specified in the Schedule.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the schedule and instructions relating to reservation for the purpose of clause (3) of article 29 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment;
- (b) by promotion;
- (c) by transfer.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and, in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit laid down in the schedule for that post.

4. **Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of Bangladesh; provided that this clause shall not apply in the case of a person who is already in the service of the Republic.
- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director of Health Services to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless—

- (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the specified post; and
- (b) in the case of a person already in Government service or in the service of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.

5. **Appointment by promotion.**—(1) Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made on the recommendation of such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may constitute in this behalf:

Provided that appointment by promotion to a specified post of higher class shall be made on the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post if he has unsatisfactory records of service.

6. **Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation—

(a) in the case of direct recruitment for a period of two years from the date of appointment; and

(b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment:

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period,—

(a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and

(b) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(3) After the completion of the period of probation, including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority—

(a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and

(b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may—

(i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and

(ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he has fulfilled such conditions, passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, prescribe.
