No. VDP-10/80-177.—The Government is pleased to make the following amendments in the Bangladesh VDP Welfare Fund Rules, 1980 as published vide Notification No. 35-Mins/HA (VDP), dated the 6th February, 1980:

#### Amendments

In the said Notification-

For rule 2 the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"2. Application.—These rules shall apply only to the bona fide members of the Village Defence Parties as well as of the Town Defence Parties which include Leaders and Assistant Leaders;"

For sub-rule (C) of rule 3 the following shall be substituted, namely:-

- "(C) "District Committee" means the District Committee of management consisting of—
  - (i) Deputy Commissioner as Chairman,
  - (ii) Superintendent of Police as Vice-Chairman,
  - (iii) District Adjutant of VDP as Member-Secretary, and
  - (iv) Subdivisional Officers as Members.

#### For Dacca Metropolitan Area

- (v) Commissioner, Dacca Metropolitan Police as Chairman,
- (vi) District Adjutant, TDP, Dacca, as Member-Secretary, and
- (vii) Assistant Commissioners of Dacca Metropolitan Police In-charge of divisions as Members.

#### For Chittagong Metropolitan Area

- (viii) Commissioner, Chittagong Metropolitan Police as Chairman.
- (ix) District Adjutant, TDP, Chittagong, as Member-Secretary, and
- (x) Assistant Commissioners of Chittagong Metropolitan Police Incharge of divisions as Members."

In between the rules 5 and 9, wherever the abbreviation VDP occurs, the sign and the abbreviation "TDP" shall be added after the same.

#### Jails Section-I

#### NOTIFICATION

#### Dacca, the 17th June, 1980

No. 252-Mins/HA/(Jails-I).—Whereas an incident took place in the Rangpur District Jail in the morning of May 21st 1980 in which 12 persons were injured including the Police;

And whereas the Government is of opinion that it is necessary to hold a judicial enquiry into the incident;

Now, Therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by section 3 of the Commission of Inquiry Act, 1956 (VI of 1956), the Government is pleased to appoint Kazi Bashiruddin, District Judge, Rangpur, to enquire into the circumstances and cause of the incident.

The terms of reference to inquiry shall be as follows:-

- (i) To ascertain the circumstances under which the trouble broke out, persons responsible for it and whether the disturbance was preventable.
- (ii) To ascertain if any excess was committed in quelling the trouble and to identify the persons who were responsible for the occurrence of such incidents.
- (iii) To suggest ways and means to prevent recurrence of such incidents in future.

The report of the Inquiry Commission shall be submitted to Government within a month from the commencement of the inquiry.

The Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 215-Mins/HA/(Jails-I), dated the 23rd May 1980 appointing Mr Shamsuddin Ahmed, District and Sessions Judge, Rajshahi, for inquiry into the incident is hereby cancelled.
