No. S.R.O. 218-L/81/1R-7/D-21/80.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 176A of the Army Act, 1952 (XXXIX of 1952), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Army Regulations (Rules), Volume-I, namely:—

In the aforesaid Regulations after regulation 411A, the following new regulation 411B shall be inserted, namely:—

- "411B. Electrical and Mechanical Engineering Corps Commanders' Conference.—A conference of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering Corps Commanders shall be convened once annually at a time and place and for a duration to be decided by the Director of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering Corps. The following will attend the conference:—
 - (a) The Director of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering.
 - (b) The Deputy Director or Inspector of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering.
 - (c) All Lieutenant Colonels and all Commanders of the Electrical and Mechanical Engineering Corps.
 - (d) One Deputy Assistant Director of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering Directorate, to be nominated by the Director of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering.
 - (e) The Deputy Assistant Director of Electrical and Mechanical Engineering, Logistic Area.
 - (f) The Commandant, Electrical and Mechanical Engineering Centre and School with one officer to be nominated by him.
 - (g) The Commandant, Base Workshop Electrical and Mechanical Engineering with one officer to be nominated by him.
 - (h) The Officers Commanding Independent Workshop Companies, Electrical and Mechanical Engineering.
 - (i) The Commanding Officer Army Aviation Engineering Workshop, Electrical and Mechanical Engineering.
 - (j) Any other officer specially nominated by the Director, Electrical and Mechanical Engineering."
