No. S.R.O. 218-L/80/567/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and section 7 of the Sales Tax Act, 1951 (III of 1951), the Government is pleased to exempt the goods specified in column (2) of the Table below and falling under the Heading Nos. of the First Schedule to the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), as specified in column (1) of the said Table from the whole of Customs-duties and Sales tax leviable thereon if these goods are imported between the 5th day of July, 1980 and the 11th day of August, 1980 (both days inclusive):

NOTIFICATIONS

Dacca, the 4th July, 1980

No. S.R.O. 219-L/80/MVRT/Bus-49/80.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 33, read with section 19A of the Road Transport Corporation Ordinance, 1961 (E.P. Ordinance VII of 1961), the Government is pleased to make the following amendments in the Road Transport Corporation (Indemnity Fund) Rules, 1966, namely:—

In aforesaid Rules,—

- (a) throughout the rules,—
  - (i) the word "East Pakistan" shall be *omitted*; and
  - (ii) for the word "rupees" the word "Taka" shall be *substituted*;
- (b) in rule 6, for the words "Provincial Government" the word "Government" shall be *substituted*; and
- (c) in rule 9, for the words "five thousand" occurring twice the words "ten thousand" shall be *substituted* in both the places.
