No. S.R.O. 261-L/80/PE/502-27/78-340.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 33 of the Ports Act, 1980 (XV of 1980), the Government is pleased to make the following further alteration in the First Schedule to the said Act, namely:—

In the aforesaid Schedule, in Part V, for the entries relating to the Port of Chittagong, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

	(iv) Country crafts including ballam boats and cargo boats of below 10 tons.	Not exceeding Taka 0.20 per gross registered ton or fraction thereof.	Ditto.

Name of Port.	Vessels chargeable.	Rate of port dues.	Dues how often chargeable in respect of same vessel.
(v)	Vessels entering the port in ballast and not carrying passenger or cargo.	3/4th of the dues otherwise payable by such vessels.	One, each entry.
(vi)	Vessels entering in port for repairs or through stress of weather.	1/2 of the dues otherwise payable by such vessels.	Ditto.
(vii)	Vessels entering the port and taking in only provisions, water, bunker coal or liquid fuel for their own consumption.	1/2 of the dues otherwise payable by such vessels.	Ditto.

Explanation:—For calculating the dues payable by a vessel, the weight of the deck cargo shall be added to its gross registered tonnage.

O. 262-L/80/PE/5R-27/78-341.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 35 of the Ports Act, 1908 (XV of 1908), and in supersession of all previous notifications issued in this behalf, Government is pleased to direct that fees for pilotage at the port of Chittagong shall be charged at the following rates, namely:—

2. An additional pilotage fee of 50 per cent of the pilotage fees specified above shall be charged in respect of vessels breaking journey at Gupta Khal in order to take delivery of bunkers at the Tanker Moorings.

3. If pilotage work takes place wholly or in part between 6 p.m. and 6 a.m. a fee at the rate of 1½ time of the pilotage fee specified above shall be charged plus an additional fee at the following rates, namely:—

for vessels of which gross tonnage does not exceed 3,999 tons Taka 160·00

for vessels of which gross tonnage exceeds 3,999 tons but does not exceed 4,999 tons.	Taka 320.00
for vessels of which gross tonnage exceeds 4,999 tons	Taka 400.00

4. The above rates shall come into force after expiration of 30 days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.
