No. S.R.O. 268-L/81/346-Poll(I).—WHEREAS the Government is of the opinion that it is expedient for the public safety to prohibit absolutely the manufacture, possession and importation of explosives within the limits of whole of Khulna district;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 6 of the Explosives Act, 1884 (IV of 1884), the Government is pleased to prohibit absolutely the manufacture, possession and importation of explosives within the limits of whole of Khulna district.

2. This notification shall remain in force for a period of one year commencing on the date of its publication in the official Gazette.
