No. S.R.O. 275-L/83.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of sub-section (2) of section 280 of the Cantonments Act, 1924 (II of 1924), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Cantonment Servants Rules, 1954, the same having been previously published as required by sub-section (1) of the said section, namely;—

In the aforesaid Rules .-

- (1) throughout the rules, unless otherwise provided,-
 - (a) for the word "Pakistan" the word "Bangladesh" shall be substituted; and
 - (b) for the words "Central Government" the word "Government" shall be substituted;
- (2) in rule I, in sub-rule (I), the word "Pakistan" shall be omitted;
- (3) in rule 2; in sub-rule (I), clause (g) shall be omitted;
- (4) in rule 7.-
 - (a) for sub-rule (I), the following shall be substituted, namely:-
 - "(i) Subject to the provisions of sub-rule (Ia), the Executive Officer shall appointment all servants whose pay on appointment is below four hundred taka per mensem";

- (b) in sub-rule (Ia), for the word "rupees" the word "taka" shall be substituted; and
- (c) in sub-rule (3), for the words "Central Government or any Provincial Government" the word "Government" shall be substituted;
- (5) in rule 8, in sub-rule (I), in clause (d), for the words "a Provincial or Central Legislature" the word "Parliament" shall be substituted;
- (6) in rule 42, in sub-rule (2), in clause (c), for the words "State Bank of Pakistan" the words "Bangladesh Bank" shall be substituted;
- (7) in rule 48, the word "Pakistan" shall be omitted;
- (8) in rule 51,-
 - (a) in sub-rule (I), for the letters and figure "Rs. 120" the word and figure "Taka 300" shall be substituted; and
 - (b) in sub-rule (2), for the letters and figure "Rs. 5" the word and figure "Taka 10" shall be substituted;
- (9) in rule 54, in sub-rule (I), for the word "Pakistan" the word "the People's Republic of Bangladesh" shall be substituted; and
- (10) in rule 61, the word "Pakistan" shall be omitted.
