**No. S.R.O. 279-L/79.**—In pursuance of clause (b) of sub-section (2B) of section 14A of the Income-tax Act, 1922 (XI of 1922), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to direct that the following further amendment shall be made in the Notification No. S.R.O. 340-L/75, dated the 30th September, 1975, namely:—

In the aforesaid Notification,—

- (a) in the citation, for the words “for the purposes of that clause” the words, brackets, figure and letter “to be the industries for the purposes mentioned in sub-section (2A) of the aforesaid section” shall be substituted; and
- (b) after serial 23 and the entries relating thereto, the following shall be added, namely:—
  - “24. Any industry involving a manufacturing process.
  25. Any other industry as may be decided by the National Board of Revenue in consultation with the Ministry of Industries.”
