No. S.R.O. 298-L/82.—The following draft of certain further amendments in the Urban Immovable Property Tax Rules, 1957, which the Government proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 of the Urban Immovable Property Tax Act, 1957 (E.P. Act XI of 1957), is hereby published as required by the said section for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and a notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration on or after the 13th September, 1982.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received from any person in respect of the said draft before the date specified above will be considered by the Government:

Draft amendments

In the aforesaid Rules,-

- (1) in rule 5, in sub-rule (1), for the words "the annual value of which exceeds six thousand Taka" the words and commas "the annual value of which exceeds, in the case of Dacca Metropolitan Area, eighteen thousand Taka and, in the case of other areas, twelve thousand Taka" shall be substituted; and
- (2) for rule 16AA the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"16AA. Jurisdiction.—(1) A Commissioner of Taxes shall perform the functions under these rules for such areas as may be assigned to him by the Board for the purpose of income-tax under the Income-tax Act, 1922 (XI of 1922).

- (2) An appellate Joint Commissioner of Taxes shall perform the functions under these rules for such areas as may be assigned to him by the Board for the purpose of income-tax under the Income-tax Act, 1922 (XI of 1922).
- (3) A Deputy Commissioner of Taxes shall perform the functions under these rules for such areas as may be assigned to him by the Commissioner of Taxes for the purpose of income-tax under the Income-tax Act, 1922 (XI of 1922)".

NOTIFICATION

No. S. R. O. 302-L/82/748/Cus.-In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and in supersession of this Division's Notification No. S.R.O. 212-L/76/302/D/Cus., dated the 26th June, 1976, the Government is pleased to exempt diesel motor cars having engine capacity up to 1600 cc falling under Heading No. 87.02 of the First Schedule to the said Act from so much of the customs-duties leviable thereon as is in excess of 50% ad valorem, subject to the following conditions, namely:-

- (i) that at the time of assessment the words "imported for Registration as Taxi-cab" shall be stamped prominently on all copies of bills of entry. The Motor Vehicles Registration Authority shall not register any diesel car without verification of the owner's original triplicate copy of the bill of entry and this will not be changed for private use;
- (ii) that the importers shall furnish an unconditional bank guarantee up to 100% of the value of the imported car to the Collector of Customs in the form specified by him for the purpose, which will be released on production of the registration of the imported vehicle as a taxicab to the concerned Collector of Customs.
