

No. S.R.O.323-L/83/LMVIII/5(4)/83.—Whereas the Government is of the opinion that all classes of employment under the Bangladesh Bank, Sonali Bank, Janata Bank, Agrani Bank, Pubali Bank, Rupali Bank, Uttara Bank, Bangladesh Krishi Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Rin Sangstha, Investment Corporation of Bangladesh and House Building Finance Corporation are essential for maintaining services necessary to the life of the community;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Essential Services (Second) Ordinance, 1958 (E.P. Ord. XLI of 1958), the Government is pleased to declare all classes of employment under the Bangladesh Bank, Sonali Bank, Janata Bank, Agrani Bank, Pubali Bank, Rupali Bank, Uttara Bank, Bangladesh Krishi Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Rin Sangstha, Investment Corporation of Bangladesh and House Building Finance Corporation to be classes of employment to which the said Ordinance applies.

IN THE COURT OF THE ADDITIONAL SESSIONS AND SPECIAL TRIBUNAL JUDGE, JAMALPUR

Special Powers Act Case No. 4/81

Whereas accused (1) Chand Miah and (2) Monir Ahmed, son of (1) Afsar Ali and (2) late Azimuddin of Vill. Bakakua and Dhansail, respectively, P.S. Jhinaigati, Dist. Jamalpur, are required for the purpose of trial before this court in connection with Special Powers Act Case No. 4/81, arising out of G.R. Case No. 243(2)74 and Nalitabari P.S. Case No. 16(6)74, under section 156(8) S.C. Act with 16(A) Special Powers Act, 1974;

And whereas the undersigned has reason to believe that accused (1) Chand Miah and (2) Monir Ahmad are absconding and concealing themselves so that they may not be arrested and produced before this court for trial;
