NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 20th September 1982

No. S.R.O. 339-L/82/MVRT/3M-38/82.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 21, 41 and 68 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1939 (IV of 1939), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Motor Vehicles Rules, 1940, the same having been previously published as required under sub-section (1) of section 133 of the said Act, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules,—

(a) in rule 3,—

- (i) in clause (a), for the words “the Dacca” the word “a” shall be substituted;
- (ii) in clause (b), for the words “Deputy Commissioner” the words “Superintendent of Police” shall be substituted;

(b) in rule 29,—

- (i) in clause (i), for the words “the Dacca” the word “a” shall be substituted;
- (ii) in clause (ii), for the words “Deputy Commissioner” the words “Superintendent of Police” shall be substituted.

NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 21st September, 1982

No. S.R.O. 340-L/82/751/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Sales Tax Ordinance, 1982 (Ord. XVIII of 1982), the Government is pleased to exempt all aircraft spare parts, aircraft components and aircraft accessories imported by the Bangladesh Biman for use in their aircrafts only from so much of customs duties leviable thereon as is in excess of 2½% *ad valorem* and whole of sales tax.

2. This Notification shall be deemed to have come into force on and from 2nd day of August 1982.
