No. S.R.O. 353-L/83/MVRT/2T-8/83.—The following draft of certain further amendments of the Bengal Motor Vehicles Rules, 1940, which are proposed to be made, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 41 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1939 (Act IV of 1939), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of section 133 of the said Act for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the draft will be taken into consideration on or after 15th September 1983.

Any objection or suggestion, which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft before the date specified, will be considered by the Government:

Draft Amendments.

In the Bengal Motor Vehicles Rules, 1940,-

- (a) in rule 36, for sub-rule (b), the following shall be substituted, namely:-
 - "(b) An application for the grant or renewal of certificate of fitness shall be made in Form C F A or C F R A, as the case may be, to the inspector of motor vehicles in whose jurisdiction the vehicle is normally kept or whose functional area includes the major portion of the route or area to which the permit relating to the vehicle extends.

(bb) The application under sub-rule (b) shall be accompanied with fee prescribed in sub-rule (h):

Provided that if an application for grant or renewal of certificate of fitness is made after fifteen days of the registration or after the date of expiry of the last certificate of fitness, as the case may be, such application shall be accompanied with an additional fee at the rate of 50% of the fee prescribed for certificate of fitness under sub-rule (h) for each month or a fraction thereof subsequent to the period of time mentioned above:

Provided further that no additional fee may be charged, if the owner in advance informs the inspector of motor vehicles in writing stating the reasons therein that he does not propose to obtain certificate of fitness and surrenders to the registering authority the certificate of registration and other documents issued to him authorising the use of the vehicle in a public place." and

(b) In the LIST OF FORMS, in FORM C F A and in FORM C F R A, for the words "REGISTERING AUTHORITY" wherever occurs the words "INSPECTOR OF MOTOR VEHICLES" shall be substituted.
