No. S.R.O. 355-L/81/673/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Sales Tax Act, 1951 (III of 1951), and clause (b) of section 21 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to make the following amendment in its Notification No. S.R.O. 283-L/81/661/Cus., dated the 31st August 1981, namely:—

In the aforesaid Notification, in Annexure II, under the heading "B. PACKING MATERIALS USED IN THE MANUFACTURE OF PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCTS BUT NOT EXCLUSIVELY", for item 3 the following shall be *substituted*, namely:—

- "3. Glass bottles/Jars/Phials/Ampoules/Tubes/Vials, all sorts, excluding Amber glass bottles".

Dacca, the 31st October 1981

No. S.R.O. 360-L/31/LIWVI/6(1)/80.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Shops and Establishments Act, 1965 (E.P. Act VII of 1965), the Government is pleased to suspend the operation of the provisions of sections 4, 8, 10 and 11 of the said Act in respect of the establishments mentioned in the Schedule below for the period beginning on the 1st November 1981, and ending on the 30th April 1982, subject to the following conditions, namely:—

- (a) The workers required to work overtime shall be paid wages at double the rate of ordinary wages for working beyond the normal working hours.
- (b) The workers deprived of weekly holidays shall be allowed compensatory weekly holidays within a month after the 30th day of April 1982.

### NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 31st October 1981

**No. S.R.O. 362-L/81/436.Poll(I).**—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 6 of the Explosives Act, 1884 (IV of 1884), the Government is pleased to make the following amendment in this Ministry's Notification No. S.R.O. 318-L/81/379-Poll(I), dated the 17th September 1981, namely—

In the aforesaid Notification, in the first paragraph, in the second sub-paragraph, for the full-stop at the end a colon shall be *substituted* and thereafter the following proviso shall be *added*, namely:

“Provided that the Petrobangla, Dacca, shall be exempt from the operation of the prohibition under this notification and the two notifications referred to above so that the Petrobangla may shift explosives from its main explosive magazine at Pomra, Chittagong for carrying out survey for the purpose of exploration of petroleum within the limits of Sylhet, Mymensingh, Tangail, Rangpur, Dinajpur, Bogra, Rajshahi, Kushtia, Jessore, Khulna, Faridpur and Pabna districts”.

2. This notification shall come into force on the date of its publication in the official Gazette.

ORDER

Dacca, the 30th October 1981

No. JP-3(1)/81.—In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by and under section 5(2) of the Record of Jute Growers (Border Areas) Act, 1974, I, Director of Jute, hereby direct that every grower of jute within the 10-mile border belt shall sell on or before the 15th December, 1981, the entire quantity of jute produced by him in the current year, after retaining, if he so likes, not more than two maunds for his own consumption, to the Government Jute Corporations and licensed jute dealers engaged in lifting border jute.
