No. S.R.O. 449-L/83/SD-1/1981.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 82 of the Bangladesh Order, 1972 (P.O. No. 127 of 1972), the Board of Directors of the Bangladesh Bank, with the approval of the Government, in pleased to make the following amendments in the Bangladesh Bank Geneal Regulations, 1977, namely:—

In the aforesaid Regulations, in Regulation 19, -

- (a) for sub-regulation (1), the following shall be substituted, namely:
  - "(1) The Directors nominated under sub-clause (c) of clause (3) of
    Article 9 of the Order shall receive a fee of Taka two hundred
    for attending each meeting of the Board or of the Committee
    in addition to travelling expenses, if any."; and
- (b) in sub-regulation (2), under the heading "Scales", in clause (iii),-
  - (i) for the figure, brackets and words "100 (one hundred only)" the words "two hundred" shall be substituted; and
  - (ii) for the words "two days" the words "three days" shall be substituted.
