No. S.R.O. 404-L/82.—The following draft of certain further amendments in the Income Tax Rules, which the National Board of Revenue proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 59 of the Income-Tax Act, 1922 (XI of 1922), is hereby published as required by sub-section (4) of the said section for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration on or after 31st of December 1982.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received from any person in respect of the said draft before the date specified above will be considered by the Board;

Draft Amendments

In the aforesaid Rules, in rule 49A, for the words figures and brackets "rate of 2½% of the value of the imported goods exceeding Taka 1,00,000 (Taka one Lakh)" the following shall be substituted, namely:—

4. Where the value of imported goods exceed Taka 1,00,000 3% of the value of imported goods".

XLI of 1958), the Government is pleased to extend the declaration made under this Ministry's Notification No. S.R.O. 174-L/82/LI WVII/5(6)/82, dated the 5th June, 1982, to the effect that all classes of Employment under the Bangladesh Bank, Sonali Bank, Janata Bank, Agrani Bank, Pubali Bank, Rupali Bank, Uttara Bank, Bangladesh Krishi Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Rin Sangstha, Investment Corporation of Bangladesh and House Building Finance Corporation to be classes of employment to which the said Ordinance applies for a further period of six months with effect from the 5th December, 1982.
