Dhaka, the 13th December, 1982

No. S.R.O. 416-L/82/3A-19/D-21/80.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 176A of the Army Act, 1952 (XXXIX of 1952), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Army Regulations (Rules), namely :—

In the aforesaid Regulations (Rules), for rule 411A the following shall be substituted, namely:—

“411A. Annual conference of engineers.—A conference of engineer officers may be convened once in every year at such time and place as may be decided by the Engineer-in-Chief. The conference, the duration of which shall not exceed two days, shall be attended by the following officers:—

1. Director of Engineers, with one staff officer;
2. Commander, Independent Engineer Brigade;
3. Director of Works (Engineer-in-Chief's Branch);
4. Director of Works and Chief Engineers (Army, Navy and Air-Force);
5. Commandant, Engineer Centre and School of Military Engineering;
6. Commanding Officers, Engineer Battalion or equivalent units;
7. Commanders, Military Engineers Service (Army, Navy and Air-Force);
8. Officer Commanding, Independent Field Companies or equivalent units;
9. Senior Record Officer; and
10. Two officers (of or above the rank of a Colonel) from ERE as per requirement.”
